Please can children be wearing school shoes and not trainers when it is a normal uniform day.

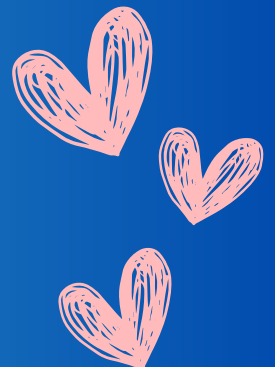

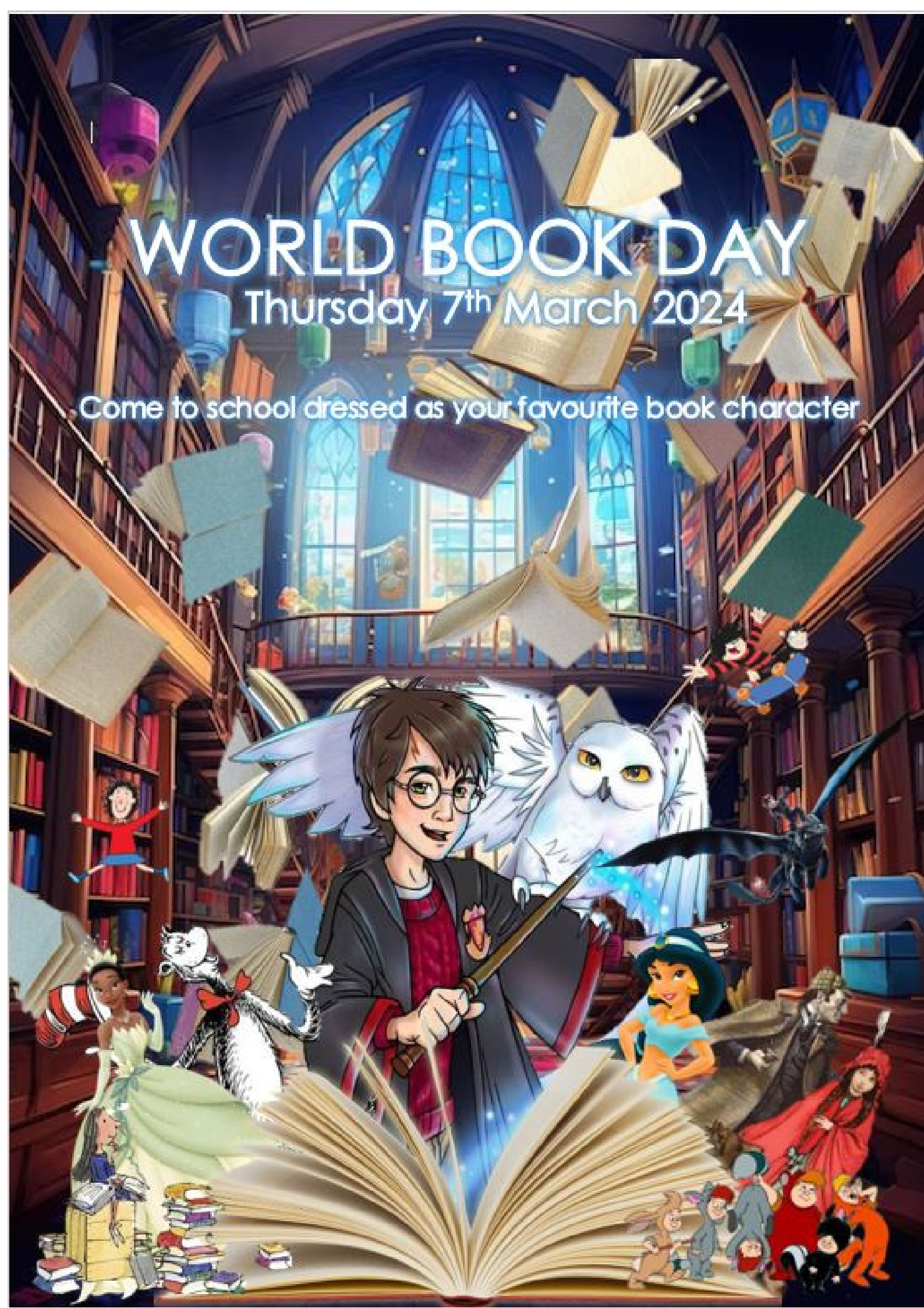
