NURSERY CHILDREN

Since Christmas, we have welcomed thirteen new children into our Nursery class. We are so proud of how well they have settled into nursery life. Please do be patient with the Nursery staff as they get to know you. It is likely that our newer children will be let out later than the other children to ensure we are sending the right child with the right parent. It doesn't take long for us to be able to match children to their family members so thanks in advance for your understanding.

LIBRARY

The library will be open after school on Monday to all of our KS2 children. We hope to see you there! If you already have a book and are in KS2 please return it to school on Monday too.

HOME READING BOOKS

All reading books in key stage 1 will now be placed in a sturdy, plastic wallet before going in your child's book bag. This is to protect them further. We had a brand new book that went home last week for the first time and it came back water damaged. I have spent £2,500 on new books recently and it is vital that they are respected and looked after. Please support us in teaching your child NOT to put their water bottle in with the school books. Please teach them how to look after them at home too. Thanks

PARKING

We have seen many improvements this week with parking, so thank you very much for that. We do still have a tiny minority who are driving recklessly and endangering the lives of their own, and other's, children. There are a few simple rules that will support the safety outside of school:

- Do not let your child jump out of a car that is on the road and has not been parked
- Do not stop by the zebra crossings
- Never drive over the zebra crossing when an adult or child is on it
- It is an offence to park within ten metres of a junction (i.e. Dunsmore Avenue
- It is an offence to leave children unattended in a car, unless this is on a petrol forecourt. We will report this if we see young children left in cars on their own.

We have been in touch with the council again this week to see if there is anything that can be done to improve safety outside the school. Once they come for a visit, we will inform you of their outcomes, but in the meantime thanks again for those who respect the road.

If it means you have to park and then walk for two or three minutes, then please do so. Better still, for those of you who live close enough, why not leave the car at home and let the children walk home from school. Mick and our family support workers will be outside the school to see if they can help things improve in any way. Please be polite to our hard-working staff if they speak with you about how to park or drive more safely—it is for the benefit of our children!

SACRAMENTS

Fr David has now opened the window for parents of children in **year 2 and above** who wish to apply for their child to receive the sacrament of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in the summer of 2021. You must have applied by **January 19th**. After this date you will only be considered for the year after. (2022) You do have to be a practising Catholic to be considered. You can make an appointment with Fr David by phoning the presbytery on: 02760448170. Parents of children in **year 5 and above** can apply for their child to receive the sacrament of Confirmation in 2021. The deadline date is the same, **19.1.2020**.
