PARENT CONSULTATION EVENINGS

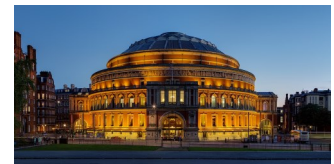

TIC TOC

Tic toc is the name now given to an app once called musically. It had to change its name because there were a lot of very negative press around musically with regards to how safe it was as a platform for young girls. There were lots of cases of grooming and exploitation on it and it was deemed unsafe, particularly if children under the recommended age were using it. Since its renaming and rebranding, the problems with it have not gone away. Please be extremely mindful if you allow your child to use this social media platform. If you decide you are happy with your child using it (bearing in mind that it is clearly stated that it is not suitable for children under the age of 13) we urge you to have full access to it and DO access it regularly. Insist on seeing what (if anything is posted) and check messages regularly. Some of the content within it is very inappropriate! We have had issues this week where a craze that originated in tic toc has made its way into school. Children have been saying 'salt and vin' to a child and asking them to complete. When the child then says the rest of the word 'vinegar' they are shouting that the child has used a racist slur and attempted to get the child into trouble. This is one example of many things that we believe young children should not be exposed to and copying.

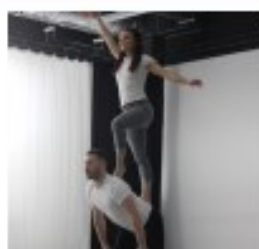

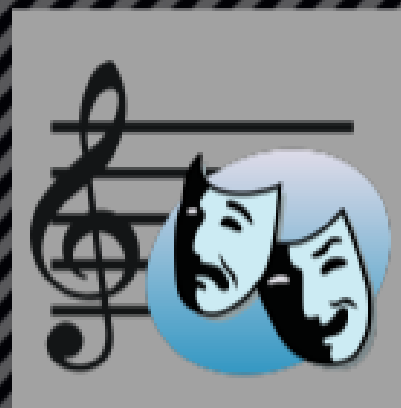
