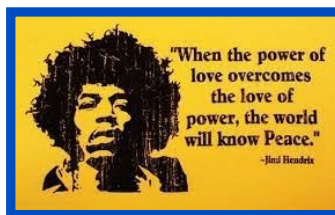
PARENT QUESTIONNAIRE

Thank you to each of our parents who have taken the time to complete our parent questionnaire.
