### READING BOOKS

I know that I have asked this many times, but please may I repeat my plea for children to take care of the reading books that are sent home. Reading at home is absolutely vital for pace and fluency, but it is costing us a small fortune as we are constantly having to replace books.. Most of the books we buy come in packs of ten, so we cannot simply buy one book to replace that which is damaged. Most become damaged because either drink or dinner is spilt in them. However, we have many that simply get ripped beyond repair. Reading at the dinner table is not conducive to a valuable reading at home session. It needs to be a special few minutes set aside that are purely for focussing on reading. Please take care of our books—each one ruined is one less for other children to be able to use.

### TERMLY MERIT ASSEMBLY

We are absolutely delighted to be able to inform you that we will be able to invite parents into school for this term's merit assembly. It has been over two years now since we have welcomed parents into the school building. It is so exciting to see school returning to how it once used to be. Keep your eyes peeled to see if your child has been chosen. If they have, more information will be sent to you shortly.

### BIKES AND SCOOTERS

More and more children are coming to school on either bikes or scooters. May we ask before the children are at the school gate please can they dismount their bikes and scooters and push these into school. There are scooter and bike racks for these to be left. They should not be ridden on school grounds as it could cause an accident. Also we ask that siblings do the same.

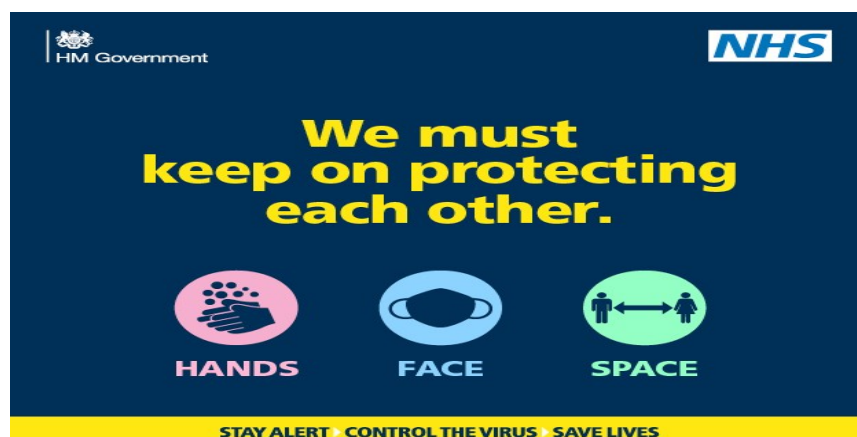
