CONGRATULATIONS

Last week, the school completed at the Coventry Catholic Schools Athletic event. Overall our school came fourth, which is an amazing achievement out of the 18 schools that took part. We were highest placed small school. We had two individual exceptional achievements. Both Jack T (year 3) and Eryk W (year 5) broke the existing boys' records for their year groups in the sprints. This means they are fastest boys EVER in Coventry to have run over that distance. We are so proud of you boys...this is amazing. Keep training hard—more of the same next year!

At this year's event, our children looked exceptionally smart. Because of an extremely kind and generous donation from Hughie and Ava Harkin's dad, we were able to buy a full set of school logo tracksuits and school logo shorts and T-shirts. TRANSITION DAY

The Coventry transition day is on Wednesday 6th July. All of the children in school will spend the day in their new classrooms with their new teachers and support staff. The children in year 6 will spend the day at their new school. You should have heard from your child's new school to confirm arrangements. Please do contact them if you have not. It is normal practice for the children to make their own way to their new school as there is not enough room on the buses that they might be catching in September. It is really important that they attend in their St. Anne's school uniform so they can be easily identified. It is also really important that they arrive on time. We know all of our year 6 leavers will make an excellent first impression on their new staff. We hope that all children have a lovely day, one which makes them excited for the year to come.

HATTON TRIP

On Monday 4th July, the children in Reception to Year 6 will celebrate reaching the end of a wonderful school year by visiting Hatton World of Adventure. Unfortunately, we still have lots of payments still to come in. We really do rely on parent contributions to help with the transport costs for our school trips so the children can enjoy a special day with their school friends. We understand that times are very tough at the moment, so if you are having difficulty, please do contact one of the family support workers to share your concerns. If you are in a position to pay now, please do this via school money. We ask that all payments are received no later than 30th June. Lunch packs will be provided to the children that are eligible for free school meals (including universal free school meals) and for those children that have ordered one. All other children will need to bring a lunch from home in disposable packaging so this can be thrown away when finished. Please also bring plenty of extra drinks—again, they need to be in cartons or bottles that be disposed of on the day. We ask that all children bring a sun hat and ask that sun cream is applied before they come to school. So the children have a full day at the park, we have asked the coaches to collect us at 3.00pm. We will arrive back at school for approximately 3.30pm. Please can you be at school for this time to collect your child from the playground. For any reason we are held up in traffic, we will send a text message. Please ensure the office has your correct contact information.
