The only jewellery allowed in school is stud earrings. Thank you for your support.

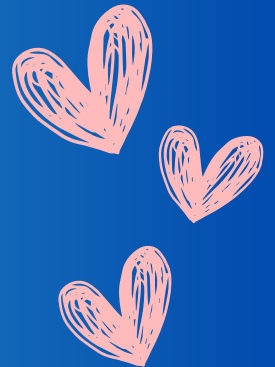
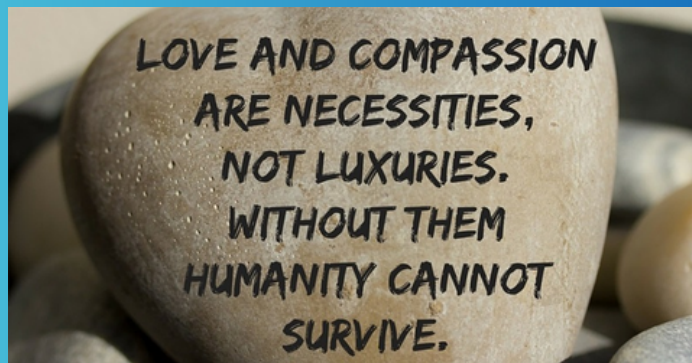
